- By 12 months of age, a baby should be babbling, pointing and waving.
- By 16 months, a baby should be using several words.
- By age 2, a baby should be using two-word meaningful phrases (not simply repeating things they've heard).
- Loss of speech or skills **AT ANY AGE** could indicate a problem.
